<p>Durable</p> 	<p>An object that is strong and hard-wearing.</p> <p>These trousers are made of durable cloth.</p>	<p>Face</p> 	<p>A surface of a geometric shape.</p> <p>A square has one face.</p>
<p>Font</p> 	<p>A printing term for the style of lettering used.</p> <p>You can change your font on Microsoft word.</p>	<p>Layering</p> 	<p>Stiffening the outer materials by putting several of the same materials together on different levels.</p> <p>Layering materials on top of one another strengthens the shape of the packaging.</p>
<p>Net</p> 	<p>The flat shape of an object such as a box.</p> <p>The net of a cube has 6 faces.</p>	<p>Prism</p> 	<p>A solid shape with ends that are similar, equal or parallel.</p> <p>A cuboid is a type of prism.</p>
<p>Packaging</p> 	<p>Materials used to wrap and protect something.</p> <p>Attractive packaging can help to sell products.</p>	<p>Scoring</p> 	<p>Cutting a line into sheet materials to make it easier to fold.</p> <p>We use scoring to help us fold in a straight line.</p>
<p>Shell structure</p> 	<p>A hollow structure with a thin outer covering.</p> <p>Toblerone has a shell structure that is a prism shape.</p>	<p>Vertex</p> 	<p>The corners of a solid shape, where the edges meet.</p> <p>A cone has one vertex.</p>
