### English

This term, children's English lessons will be centred on the texts Leon and the Place Between and Tin Forest.

We will also be using a range of fiction, non-fiction and poetry texts during our daily RAMP lessons, which helps us to improve our comprehension skills.

#### Maths

In Maths we currently learning about fractions and will be moving on to learn about money, time and shape and statistics before the end of the year.

#### Science

In science this term we are learning about plants and light We will look at the structure of plants and the function of each of its part. We will also learn about the life cycle of a plant. We will also be working with Janine from the Food Discovery Programme to plant and harvest our own food.

#### $\mathcal{P}\mathcal{E}$

This term in PE children will be taking part in Quik cricket, orienteering and athletics. PE will take place every Monday and Thursday. Please ensure your child has the correct kit in school on those days.

#### $\mathcal{R}\mathcal{E}$

To begin the term we will learn about the wonder and power of the Holy Spirit before moving on to learn about the importance of conscience in making choices. Children will also learn about special places for Jesus and the Christian community as well as learn about Islam during other faiths week.

## Geography
