Reading/Phonics

Reading remains one of our main focuses in Year

If your child is in a phonics group they will get their numbered reading book as well as a phonics book matched to their group. We expect books to be brought into school daily so that we can read with the children in school. Please listen to your child reading as much as possible and sign their reading record as completed.

Some of the children in year 2 will be moving onto Accelerated Reader and will have daily RAMP reading sessions that will focus on comprehension skills. We encourage children to complete their book quizzes at home to allow them to change their book more often.

Homework will be sent home each Friday to be completed and returned by Wednesday. This will consist of reading, spellings and times table/number skills. There will be a spelling test every Friday.
