



Reading/Phonics

Reading remains one of our main focuses in Year 2. We are now focussing on developing a love of reading and improving comprehension skills. All children will be given a library book to read at home and can change at least once a week.

If your child is in a phonics group, they will get a phonics book matched to their group.

We expect books to be brought into school daily so that we can read with the children in school. Please listen to your child reading as much as possible and sign their reading record as completed.

We encourage children to complete the questions at the back of their reading books to support their comprehension skills.

Homework

Homework will be sent home each Friday to be completed and returned by Wednesday. This will consist of reading, spellings and times table/number skills.
