## English

This term, children's English lessons will be centred around a number of key texts including *Winter's Child*, *Escape from Pompeii* and *Cinderella of the Nile*. We will also be using a range of fiction, non-fiction and poetry texts during our daily RAMP lessons, which helps us to improve their comprehension skills.

## Maths

We will start this term looking multiplication and division before moving on to study length and perimeter, fractions and mass and capacity.

## Science

In science we will start the year learning about animals including humans, which will last for the full spring term. We will be completing a number of investigations to further our understanding.

## PE

PE will take place every Monday and Thursday. Our first topic is dance where children will learn and choreograph a routine to a song and perform to an audience. Please ensure your child has a full PE kit in school. PE kits will be sent home half termly to be washed.

## RE

Our two topics for the duration of spring term are Galilee to Jerusalem and Desert to Garden. We will be looking at parables, identifying scripture and linking stories from the Bible to the teachings of Jesus throughout our RE lessons.

## Geography

In Geography we will be learning all about volcanoes, mountains and earthquakes and the consequence these can have on the world.

## History

In History we will be learning all about The Egyptians. The children will go on a trip to Bolton Museum to deepen their understanding and see a real mummy!

## Design Technology

In DT we will be designing, making and evaluating our own healthy pitta pockets. We will explore different ingredients and learn to make healthy choices.

In Art we will be creating our very own Egyptian inspired sculpture using clay and looking at the work of George Segal.
