English

This term, children's English lessons will be centred on key texts (some of which link to other areas of the curriculum). These key texts will give the children the chance to write a range of genres, such as: news reports, advertisements, descriptions, letters and diaries. We will also be using a range of fiction, non-fiction and poetry texts during our daily RAMP lessons - this helps us to improve our comprehension skills.

Maths

We will start this term looking at Multiplication & Division with a key focus on using written methods to solve calculations. We will then move onto learning about Fractions. We will also look at Decimals & Percentages during this term.

Science

In Science, our first topic will be Animals including Humans. During our second topic, we will be learning all about Living things and their Habitats.

PE

PE will take place every Monday and Wednesday. Please ensure children have full PE kit in school and that earrings are removed.

RE

Our two topics for the duration of spring term are Galilee to Jerusalem and Desert to Garden. We will be looking at parables, identifying scripture and linking stories from the Bible to the teachings of Jesus throughout our RE lessons.

Geography

For our Geography topic, we will be learning about Rainforests. We will be looking at where rainforests are in the world and what it would be like to live there.

History

In History, we will be focusing on the Anglo-Saxons and Scots. We will be exploring what life was like during this time.

Design & Technology

This term, we will focus on Food and we will be baking our own bread. We will then be taking part in a class bake-off competition to taste test our creations.

Art

Our Art topic will focus on developing our painting skills and it will link to our Science topic. Our inspirational artist will be Georgia O'Keeffe.
